Paperwork will be accepted through **Friday**, **November 1st**, **2019**. Unfortunately, it has become common practice for candidates to turn in their paperwork at the last minute, which does not allow enough time for processing and catching potential errors to ensure your success. We **STRONGLY** encourage you to turn in your paperwork at least a week before the deadline. Even if you are undecided, we suggest you turn in your paperwork in preparation to compete instead of scrambling on the day of the deadline. We want you to put your best foot forward, so what you submit to us will be given to the Judges Panel.

We are overjoyed for our eighth consecutive titleholders to compete as candidates in the Miss South Carolina Scholarship Organization. Confident that we can cultivate and refine the outstanding women in our competition for competition now, feel free to contact me if you have any questions.

MISS Candidates ONLY

Specific to the Miss Candidates is the Miss America Organization's commitment to our national platform of the Children's Miracle Network Hospitals (CMNH). Each candidate is required to raise donations of \$100.00 for each preliminary they participate in. You must create an account at www.MissAmerica4Kids.org and register for the Miss Orangeburg Competition in the 2021 competition year.

It is easy to raise the funds as the website allows you to send out emails to family and friends asking for their support of CMNH and the Miss America Organization on your behalf. In the state of South Carolina, a \$500.00 cap has been placed on fundraising that allows you to compete in unlimited preliminaries on the local level after reaching the \$500.00 cap. Excess money raised will be applied toward your state requirement should you win our local.

All funds MUST be raised by 11:59 pm on Friday September 27th to be accepted as a candidate for the 2020 competition. This is a REQUIREMENT mandated by the Miss America Organization for every candidates who competes on the Local, State, and National levels. Register soon, and start fundraising quickly to avoid any hiccups with your application for the 2020 Miss Orangeburg County Competition.

TEEN Candidates ONLY

Teen Candidates are required to pay an entry fee of \$150.00 to enter the Miss Orangeburg Teen Competition. Entry fees must be received by the deadline, **Friday**, **November 1st**, **2019**. If a teen candidate enters and wins another preliminary before our competition, we will refund their entry fee. No other refunds will be made outside of those circumstances. Private Interview - 25%

Wardrobe: Candidate's Choice: Interview Attire.

Allows insight into the candidate's ability to fulfill the responsibilities outlined in the job description and contract. Provides the opportunity to learn as much as possible about the candidate's qualities and attributes to fulfill the titleholder position

Private Interview - 25%

7 Minute Panel Interview 6 minutes of questioning, no opening or closing remarks.

You are advised to wear something that you would wear to a serious job interview. Dresses and skirt/blouse combinations are most common for candidates today.

Artistic Expression in Talent – 40%

90 seconds or less. Talent of your choice. Costume of your choice.Looks for how enjoyable and relatable the performance is

Your background music should be cut to the appropriate length and on a CD. Please check your CD on your home stereo and car stereo to make sure it plays on all devices, not just your computer.

You are not allowed to use live animals, have flames, or take off articles of clothing during your talent. Questionable talent components should be discussed with the director. Contact the director in advance if you plan to play the piano.

Artistic Expression in Talent – 35%

90 seconds or less. Talent of your choice. Costume of your choice.

Presence & Poise in Evening Wear – 20%

Allows a look into a how the candidate exhibits her own personal style, attitude, personality, grace, presence, and confidence while making her own statement about her mission for the job. Allows a chance to hear a candidate's presentation of her social impact initiative for social media in a different setting

Physical Fitness in Sportswear – 15%

Sports bra and Soffe or athletic shorts of choice. Crown Group tank top in peach \$15 payable to the CROWN Group.

Absolutely no swimsuits allowed. Designed to evaluate a candidate's commitment to physical fitness.

On-stage Interview – 15%

Wardrobe: Candidate's Choice: Interviewing for the Job.

Your On Stage Interview is a continuation of the private interview. Advancing the same criteria as the personal interview by bringing it on stage in an interactive energetic way to showcase each candidates' intelligence, personality, charisma, and aptitude for the titleholder job.

Your choice of evening gown. Please choose a gown that best compliments you and is age appropriate. This is a moment of elegance; your gown choice should reflect that. Your on-stage question will be asked at the end of your evening wear presentation. Your question will be chosen at random from a fishbowl. All questions will be appropriate for teenagers.
